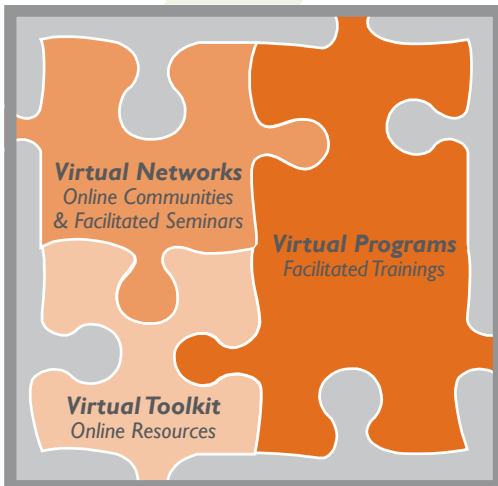

MSH's Collection of Virtual Approaches

Around the world, health professionals face similar leadership and management challenges. Often they lack access to up-to-date knowledge and resources necessary to address these challenges and manage program effectively. This is not unique to one geographical area, and health professionals can learn from the experiences of each other.

LeaderNet, an online global network, closes this gap by providing opportunities for continuous learning and peer exchange. LeaderNet focuses on priority health management, leadership, and governance topics through seminars, online forums, blogs, and resources.

Connecting Health Professionals

LeaderNet hosts multi-lingual seminars with near real-time translation of discussion posts in English, French, and Spanish. One of the most highly rated aspects of the virtual seminars, the real-time translation allows a doctor from Bolivia to discuss challenges in maintaining adequate staff with a regional hospital manager in Afghanistan. One participant noted that the challenges being discussed were so similar; it felt as if everyone was from the same country. Through this style of communication, participants realize the "answer is in the room." Instead of relying on experts to give advice, people learn from each other and develop confidence in their own solutions.
