All ADDO staff members must be accredited through a Tanzania Food and Drugs Authority–approved ADDO dispenser’s course developed and offered by the Muhimbili College of Health Sciences School of Pharmacy. The course provides basic dispenser training on ADDO-approved drugs, common indications and contraindications, common dosages, side effects, patient information, and effective communication skills. Training provided also covers the laws governing dispensing work, management and record keeping, and business ethics. Recertification at intervals will be required through completion of continuing-education programs.
